Special Education Office

- Renovation of Special Education Office: Create larger rooms for state identified special education assessments so students and school psychologists can space apart 3-6 ft.; create larger meeting room for special education case conferences to space 3-6ft. apart; and new HVAC to meet the safety regulations of staff, students, and guardians in regards to COVID and other infectious diseases.

Summer School Support Services

- Discipline officer who provided supervision, behavioral plans, and parent communication during Indian Summer Academy.
- School service coordinators to meet with students during Indian Summer Academy to adjust pathways and schedules based on summer school course completion.
- Licensed principals who provided supervision, parent communication, and monitored students' pathways and course completion during Indian Summer Academy.
- Special Ed. Director to supervise special education students and teachers during Indian Summer Academy to ensure parent communication; monitor student pathways; and monitor course completion.
- Licensed Counselor to work with students on credit recovery and monitor their course work and pathways during Indian Summer Academy.
- Licensed Director of Early Childhood who provided supervision, behavior plans, and parent communication during Indian Summer Academy.
