Good afternoon, this is Mr. McKenzie, superintendent of Mississinewa Community Schools, today is Thursday, April 30<sup>th</sup>. The reason for my call is to inform you of some changes in our meal distribution times and locations. Starting next week we will be distributing on Wednesday's instead of Monday's. There will not be a meal distribution on Monday, May 4<sup>th</sup> but we will be distributing on Wednesday, May 6<sup>th</sup>, then Wednesday May 13<sup>th</sup> and again Wednesday, May 20<sup>th</sup>. We will be closed the last week of May for the Memorial Day holiday. Starting Wednesday, May 6<sup>th</sup> we will be distributing from Westview Elementary, Northview Elementary and the High School from 4-6pm ONLY, we will no longer be distributing from 10-noon. We ask that you continue to have a paper in your windshield with the number of students you are picking up for and have your trunk popped.

Again this is FREE for all children 18 years old and under and the packages include 5 breakfast meals and 5 lunch meals. To try and ease traffic we ask that if you live in Jonesboro, please pick up from Westview Elementary School at door #7. And, if you have elementary students or younger, and you live in Gas City, please pick up from Northview Elementary School at door #3. Also, if you have students in grades 6-12 and live in Gas City, please pick up from the High School at door #9.

Finally, we will no longer expect you to sign up ahead for the "pick up" of meals.

In conclusion, I want to say thank you to all our parents/ guardians, students and community members who have been supportive and positive during this time as we find new and improved ways to serve your food each week! We hope that you will continue to pick up these meals and we will inform you of our summer plans soon! Stay safe and healthy, and know that we miss you all!!
